Pentecost Symbols in the Chancel by Pat Lewis: Two urns with curly willow painted red (next to the pulpit and lectern) represent the Pentecost fire that came down on that first Pentecost. The fire of the Holy Spirit is not to destroy but to purify and empower the followers of Jesus.

Christian Symbols on altar by Nancy Johnson:

Lamb... The lamb in Christianity represents Christ as both suffering and triumphant. In the gospel of John, John the Baptizer said of Jesus, "Behold the lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world." Because the Jews used lambs as sacrificial animals, Jesus' death on the cross came to be understood as taking the place of any and all sacrifices. The lamb is gentle, innocent and pure and Jesus was and is the perfect lamb that was slain for our salvation.

Lion... The lion was the symbol of the tribe of Judah in the Old Testament, however the book of Revelation uses the Lion of Judah in reference to Jesus (Rev. 5:5). The lion symbolizes royalty—power, dominion and strength—and that is the theme of the "revelation of Jesus Christ". Jesus is the first and the last, the King of kings and the Lord of lords. To hold to the full meaning of Jesus life, death and resurrection, the lion and the lamb are often used together.

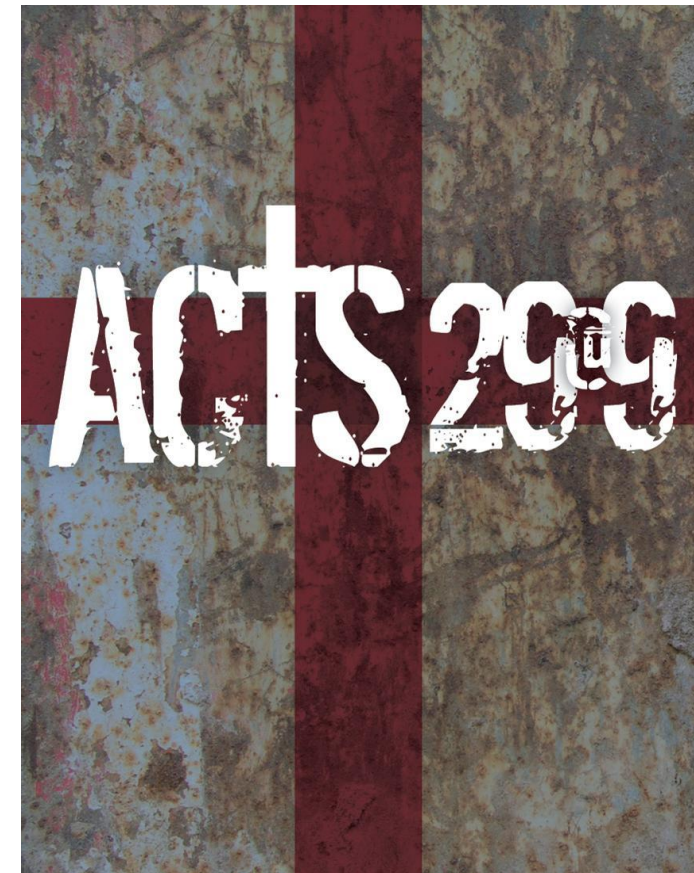
