### Pentecost Symbols on the Altar

**Monogram – XP OR CHI RHO:** Most monograms of Christ Jesus are based on Greek words, the language of the world known to the early church. In Greek, Christ (the Hebrew “Messiah”) is XPICTOC. All monograms for Christ are derived from these letters.

**Trequetra (Triangle):** A design of three equal parts which symbolizes the Holy Trinity, One God in Three Persons.

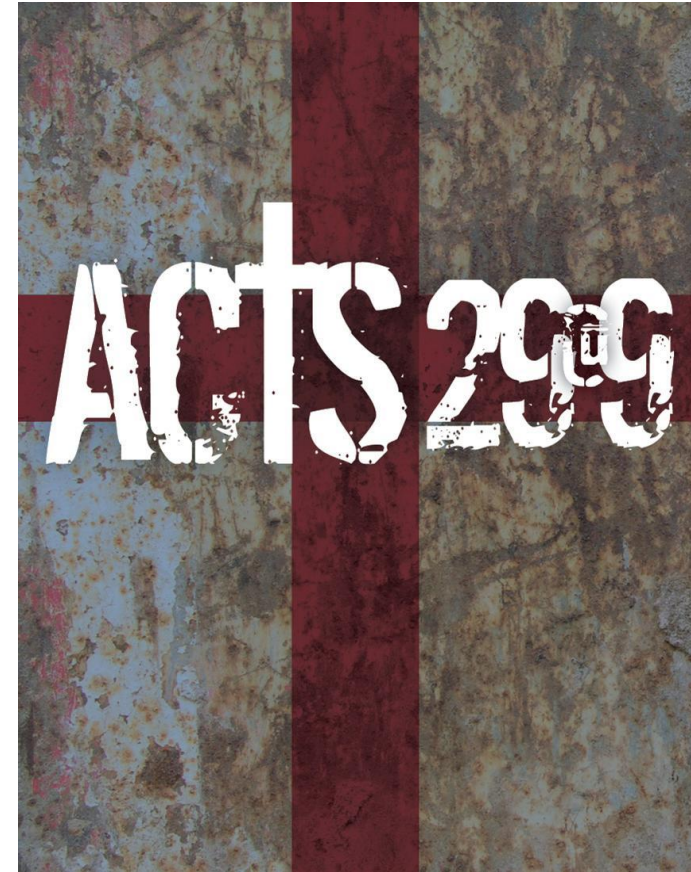
